ABOUT OUR SCCWP PROGRAMS

We currently offer the SCCWP program in a two-part process. This allows participants the most flexible approach to scheduling.

- The first portion of the class takes place in our training facility in Laurens. In this segment, one
 of our instructors will cover the required information regarding firearms safety, operations &
 storage. They will also discuss use of force, interactions with law enforcement and other legal
 requirements. Upon completion of this portion there will be a 50-question written exam with a
 passing score of at least 70%.
 - There is NO LIVE FIRE conducted during this portion of the program. Participants are encouraged to bring their firearms to class, however there is **NO LIVE AMMUNITION PERMITTED IN OUR CLASSROOM**. This segment of the class typically takes 5-6 hours depending on the experience of the individuals in the class.
- 2. The second segment of the process will take place at a local shooting range. This is done by appointment with one of our instructors and typically done in groups of 1-2 at a time, allowing our instructor to spend more time with each of the participants. We have an agreement with one local facility in Simpsonville who has been nice enough to let us make use of their indoor range, enabling us to complete this regardless of weather. We will schedule these appointments and provide information about this facility during the first portion of the class. This will consist of participants completing a 50-round course of fire at a standard silhouette target at ranges from 3 to 15 yards. Passing score on this is also 70%.
 - a. For this portion of the program the student may use their own firearm and holster or use one of our loaners.
 - i. Additional fees apply if we supply the firearm and/or ammunition.
 - ii. You can also elect to rent a firearm from the range at your expense.

Note: The range requires brass cased/FMJ ammunition.

Note: Individuals who are unfamiliar with firearms or apprehensive regarding firing a handgun are STRONGLY ENCOURAGED to participate in one of our "Guns-101" workshops prior to the "live fire" portion of the class. These sessions are held at our classroom or via our online training platform and provide participants with a chance to work with instructors in a small group, building their confidence and knowledge of firearms prior to attending the formal course.
